The Parent Zone creates a lot of resources to support parents, one example is their **Top tips for managing your child's first digital steps**:

- Balance screen time with other activities
- Be a good digital role model
- Take advantage of technical tools
- Get them thinking
- Explore together

They recommend **Three Top Tips as the days get lighter**:

Talk about location services – if you are using Google maps or similar apps to plan an outing, take the opportunity to talk to your children about understanding location services, especially when to keep your location private. Make sure they know to be careful with their privacy settings to **prevent accidental oversharing**.

Connect with caution – Remind your children not to agree to meet someone they have met on line **but do not know in real life**.

Get prepared – Think about the new term, is your child starting a new school? The internet can help with routes to school and looking at new school website.
