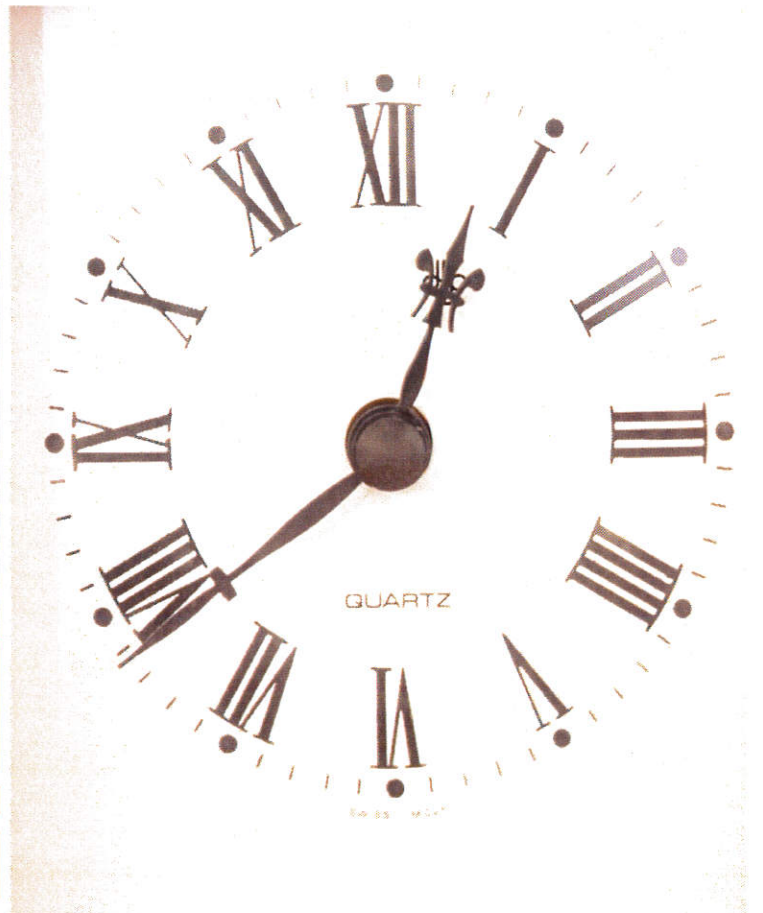


# CLASS 4



# THE ROMANS

<p>Who were the Roman army? How was Rome ruled? Who were the Roman Emperors? What was the Roman army like? How did the Romans defend Britain? - Hadrian's wall, Roman roads, building of Roman forts. Who were the Romans/Celts? How did the Romans change Britain? Look at family life. Look at Roman schools - what did children write with? Look at Roman houses - Rich houses (villas), Everyday houses - Towns. Roman Time clothing - what did soldiers wear? What do people wear generally? What did the Romans do recreation? What was Britain like before/after Roman invasion? Who was Boudicca? What did she do? What are Roman baths like? What were the Romans like at technology? - building/engineering. What happened to the Romans? What evidence remains? Look at toys Roman children played with. What animals did the Romans keep?</p>	<p>Look at settlements - why do people settle? Look at terms: invade, settle, stay, arrive, conquer, land, visit, remain. Where is Rome? Locate on a map. Map work - looking for evidence of Roman roads still in existence - name places. How did people travel around Britain? What were other settlements around Britain like? - small villages (wooden houses), villas (more wealthy). Look on a map for names of places with 'cester' or 'chester' in the title - indication of a once Roman settlement.</p>	<p>Draw/Colour/Collage pictures of Roman/Celtic Soldiers Colour mosaic patterns Make clay pots/other ornaments. Research and make Roman Artefacts for an exhibition</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Music</b></p> <p>Look at musical instruments played by the Romans. Look at a lyre - most popular instrument used by Romans - make own lyres using tissue box and elastic bands.  <b>Learn a factual song about the Romans</b></p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>RE</b></p> <p>Who did the Romans worship? Who were the Roman Gods? How did the Romans worship?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>D&amp;T</b></p> <p>Make Roman buildings Make Roman Armour Make mosaics - using tile scraps. Make pocket money pouches using wool. Make Roman Jewellery - brooches. Tie and dye - as Romans used to dye their clothes. (See Learning Log)</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Literacy</b></p> <p>Look at the Latin alphabet - write our names/secret codes using the alphabet. Make own research questions for someone else. Make fact sheets based on Romans (using PowerPoint). Make a leaflet showing people where to find Roman sites in Britain. PowerPoint presentation - Why did the Romans invade Britain?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Numeracy</b></p> <p>Roman numerals - write numbers using Roman numerals. Look at some items from Roman Times - work out cost of buying items using Roman coins. Make Roman dice - play maths games as the Romans did: board games with counters. Look at Roman calendar. Making patterns/symmetrical for shields.</p>
	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>PE</b></p> <p>Roman ball games - handball, football, field hockey, catch, dodge ball, cricket. Athletics.
