They will continue to practise strategies for subtraction and addition questions. Children will work to develop their mental strategies for all areas of numeracy including counting and times tables Children will work on finding a fraction of a shape or number. Children will work on methods for division and multiplication.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Geography/History</u> Nature.</p> <p>Looking at maps of the local area. Recording observations on map. Drawing simple maps to show where animals live. Looking at how people affect the environment. Comparing animals found in our local area to those found in other parts of the world.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>PE</u> Games</p> <p>Children will play simple games such as those with beanbags and other apparatus. They will play team games involving turn taking, passing balls and using other small equipment. Athletics involving events in sports day.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>D&T/Art</u></p> <p>Sketch animals in the local environment. Make pictures using leaves, flowers and plants. Use different mediums to create pictures of plants.</p>

Creating pictures—use tools. Practising how to save and retrieve work and print.
