<p><u>Literacy</u></p> <p>We will be looking at:</p> <p>Writing and improving sentences. Improving handwriting. Answering comprehension questions. RML phonics. Writing our own versions of traditional stories. Writing instructions. Writing reports.</p> <p>We will continue to read every day in class and will be learning how to write book reviews.</p>	<p><u>Science</u> <u>Animals including humans.</u> Children will learn that:</p> <p>Animals, including humans, have offspring which grow into adults</p> <p>Find out about and describe the basic needs of animals, including humans, for survival (water, food and air)</p> <p>Describe the importance for humans of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food, and hygiene.</p>	<p><u>Numeracy</u></p> <p>Children will study : place value up to Hundreds, Tens and Units. They will learn written strategies for subtraction and addition. Children will work to develop their mental strategies for all areas of numeracy. Completing number patterns and spotting missing numbers in sequences. Children will begin by counting in 2's, 5's and 10's and relating these to the times tables.</p>
<p><u>Geography/History</u></p> <p>Different parts of the world. Children will be looking at their local area. They will look at different types of houses. They will study a small village in India. They will study a small village in Africa. Children will follow and make simple maps. Children will look at the North and South Poles. They will learn the name of the seven continents and the five oceans.</p>	<p><u>ICT</u></p> <p>Children will look at giving instructions to simple machinery and how this affects how they work. They will be programming bee-bots to make them follow a route. They will be looking at internet safety and the potential dangers of using the internet.</p>	<p><u>D&T/Art</u></p> <p>Using different media to create pictures. Looking at famous artists. Drawing sketches.</p>
<p><u>PE—Gymnastics</u></p> <p>Children will learn why exercise is important. They will practise different ways of balancing, jumping, rolling, and travelling. They will make up short routines to link these actions together..</p>	<p><u>Music</u></p> <p>Looking at simple rhythms. Singing in a round. Using simple tuned and untuned instruments.</p>	<p><u>RE</u></p> <p>We will be learning about Christianity.</p>
