Literacy:

During this unit of work the ch will be studying a Myths and Legends and will; be focusing our writing around the Polish tale, 'Krak and the Dragon.'

Ch will have an opportunity to:

- write their own Myths story,
- write poetry about dragon
- writing newspaper report and
- take part in Drama and role play activities.

Numeracy:

During this term ch will developing their quick recall skills and strategies when solving calculations. They will also be exploring Measure including Time, money and conversions of unit (Length, volume and Mass)

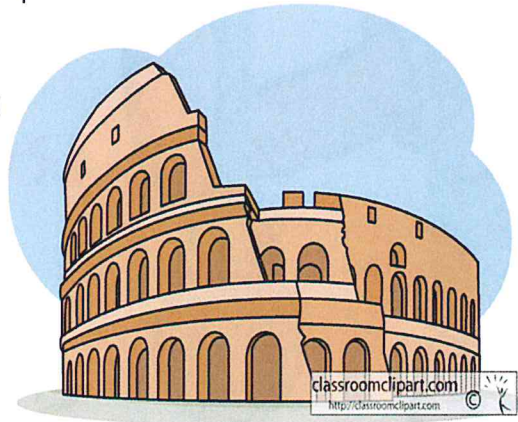
Ch will also have an opportunity to:

- Further develop their calculations using formal methods (HTU/ Column)
- Further develop multiplication strategies of 3, 4, 8 times tables.
- Solve one and two step worded problems as well as
- develop their reasoning and application of number.

RE/ PHSE:

During this term ch will be developing their awareness of people and other cultures. Develop greater understanding the world we live in; develop our understanding of other faiths and beliefs through 'Sikhism' and understanding Local democracy and politics.

Ch will be thinking about: 'How can we be positive contributing members in society?'



ICT:

For this term our focus will be "We are Film makers". AS part of the unit ch will have the opportunity to plan and create their own Stop- ~Start animation about the Romans.

Ch will explore the different types of animation and the effects used to make a film, such as CGI, Hand drawn animation and Stop- Start motion before creating their own finished film.

Science:

This term, our unit we are looking at 'Plants'. Ch will have a greater opportunity to further develop prior learning of plants by:

- Classifying and categorising different types of flowering and non-flowering plants.
- Explore the function of the different parts of flowering plants,
- Dissecting plants, to explore their various parts in addition to
- Making cross reference to a previous unit, Animals including humans, what do all living things have in common? How do plants differ?

History/ Geography:

During this term we are studying the Ancient Romans and studying at the impact they made to Britain. Ch will have an opportunity to:

- Explore the invasion, the rise and fall of Rome
- Religion - Romans Gods and Goddess,
- Food and drink as well as
- Roman Army
- Architecture
