

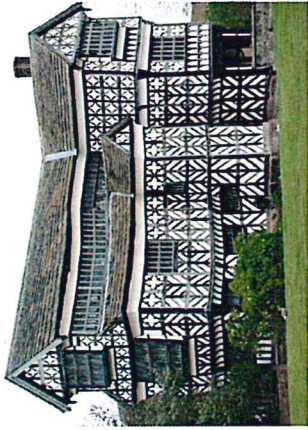
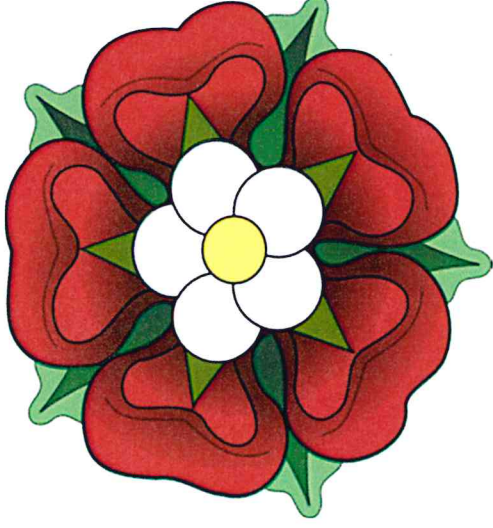
The Tudors

LITERACY:

This term we will be looking at Haikus and cinquain. Looking and examining the meaning of Tudor Haikus and then planning and writing their own. Following this we will be using Pie Corbett writing styles to create our own Tudor story using a text as help.

NUMERACY:

Children will be focusing on Number and Place value and developing their understanding of 3 and 4 digit numbers.

We will be focusing on transferring our skills on real life problems and worded problems.

Children will develop their mental strategies for all operations in numeracy (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. Focus will be the 7 and 8 times tables in multiplication.

SCIENCE:

We will be learning about 'Sound' Looking at how sound is made and how our ears work to hear this sound. We will look at Pitch, and look at pitch in relation to the distance from the object.

We will conducted experiments into how we hear sound and how sound is made.

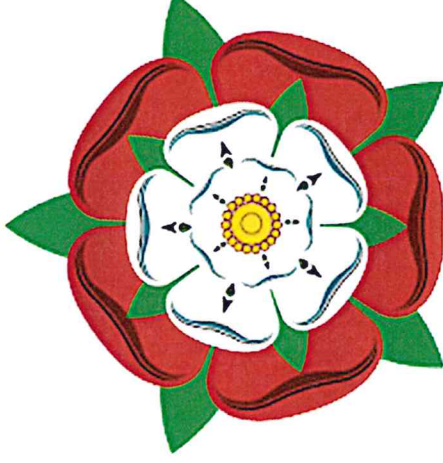
Curriculum Overview – Autumn Term

ART and DT:

ICT:

In this unit of work 'We are software developers' we will be designing, writing and debugging programs that accomplish specific goals. As well as using reasoning to explain how some simple algorithms work.

PE:

Children will be learning to develop their game skills through a variety of games. They will work individually and in teams. They will be thinking tactically about games and developing their understanding of rules.

RE:
