

LITERACY:

This term we will be looking in depth at Non-chronological reports relating back to our topic which is 'The Tudors.' Further in the term we will look at poetry as well as narrative stories.

Children will be revising and learning key SPaG terms and learning how we use these within our writing.

NUMERACY:

Children will be focusing on Number and Place value and developing their understanding of 3 and 4 digit numbers.

We will be focusing on transferring our skills in real life problems and worded problems.

As well as developing our methods of column addition and subtraction.

SCIENCE:

We will be learning about 'Sound' as discovering how sound is made and how it travels through the air. We will also be investigating how we are able to change the volume and pitch of an instrument.

This will be combined with the effects distance has upon pitch and volume.

MUSIC:

Children will be taking part in weekly music session. This will be conducted through weekly singing sessions.

Curriculum Overview – Autumn Term

ART and DT:

We are going to design and create our own Tudor puppets as well as designing our own Tudor houses.



In this unit, we will be looking at creating our own educational maths game using scratch. We will be designing, debugging and creating our own game.

We will put our own ideas and characters into the game and will be asking younger children to trial our games.

PE:

Children will be learning to develop their game skills through a variety of games. They will work individually and in teams. They will be thinking tactically about games and developing their understanding of rules.

This term the focus will be on netball.

RE:

Throughout this unit children will be learning about celebrations. Children will learn:

- What kind of celebrations people partake in.
- Why are these events celebrated?
- Key celebrations across religions around the world.

HISTORY/ GEOGRAPHY:

Throughout our history sessions, children will be focusing on:

- Tudor life
- Tudor houses (Which includes a trip to a Tudor house)
- Comparing modern England to Tudor England.
- Famous Tudors.
