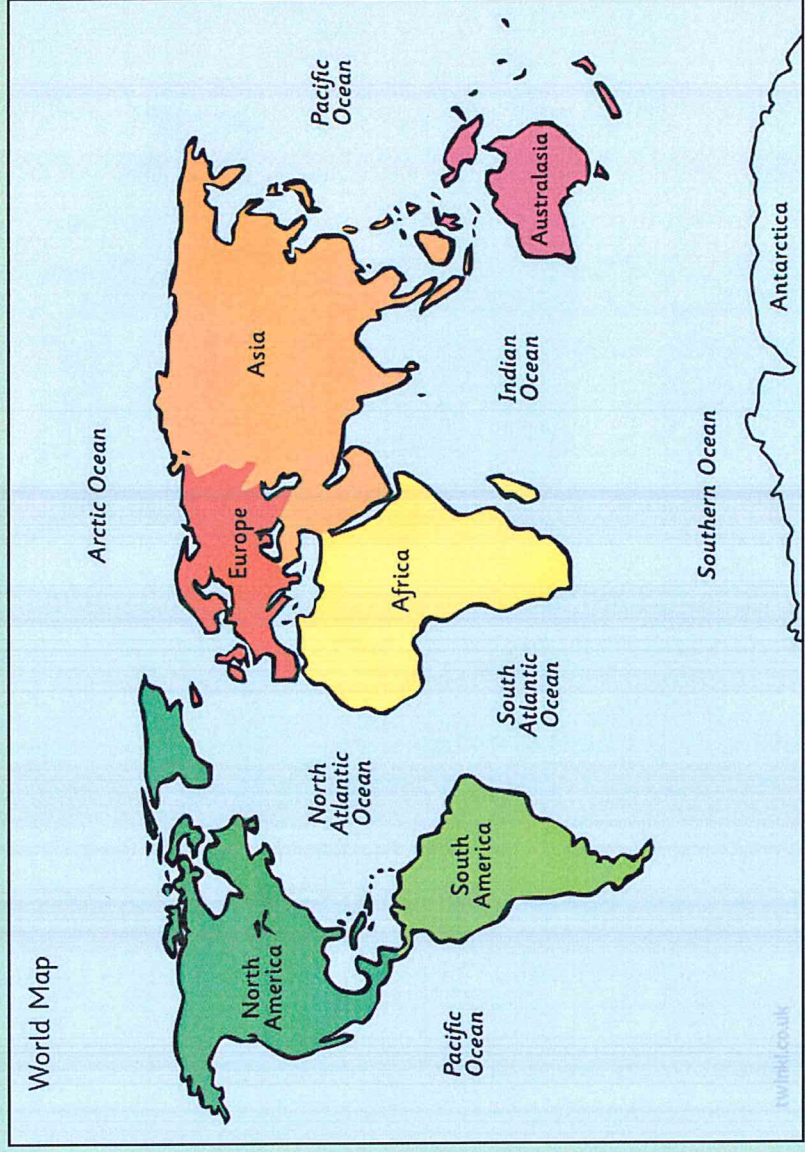


# All Around The World

## Year 2



<p><u>Literacy</u></p> <p>We will be looking at:</p> <p>RML phonics and RML spelling scheme  Improving handwriting.  Writing and improving sentences—There will be a big focus on us drafting, editing and re-writing our working to produce a final piece.  Writing setting and character descriptions  Writing reports.  Writing poems.  Writing our own versions of stories.</p> <p>We will continue to read every day in class and will be learning how to answer a range of comprehension questions too.</p>	<p><u>Science</u>  <u>Animals including humans</u></p> <p>Children will learn that:</p> <p>Animals, including humans, have offspring which grow into adults.</p> <p>Find out about and describe the basic needs of animals, including humans, for survival (water, food and air).</p> <p>Describe the importance for humans of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food, and hygiene.</p>	<p><u>Numeracy</u></p> <p>Children will study :</p> <p>Developing their written strategies for the four operations  Fractions—Halves, quarters and thirds.  Money—Recognise the coins and use the £ and p symbols. Combine amounts to make a particular value and make amounts in different ways. Add money together and be able to subtract to give change.  Completing number patterns and spotting missing numbers in sequences.</p> <p>Children will also work to develop their mental strategies for all areas of numeracy daily.</p>
<p><u>Geography</u>  <u>Different Parts of the World</u></p> <p>Year 2 will be learning the four countries in the UK and their capital cities and identifying them on a map. They will learn the name of the seven continents and the five oceans. Children will look at the North and South Poles and how the distance from the equator affects the temperature of surrounding countries. They will also study a small village in another country and compare it to West Bromwich.</p>	<p><u>ICT</u></p> <p>Children will develop an understanding of algorithms as a set of instructions and understand how these are used in computing.  They will be programming bee-bots to make them follow a route.  They will be looking at internet safety and the potential dangers of using the internet.</p>	<p><u>D&amp;T/Art</u></p> <p>Drawing sketches.  Using different media to create pictures.  Creating images using different methods e.g. collages, painting etc.  Looking at famous artists.</p>
<p><u>PE — Multi-skills</u></p> <p>Children will learn why exercise is important and take part in warming up and cooling down during session and discuss why they need to do this.</p> <p>They will be learning to catch, throw and other ball skills.</p> <p>Chn will also be taking part in the Daily Mile.</p>	<p><u>Music</u></p> <p>Looking at simple rhythms.  Singing in a round.  Using simple untuned instruments.</p>	<p><u>RE</u></p> <p>We will be learning about Christianity this term.</p>
