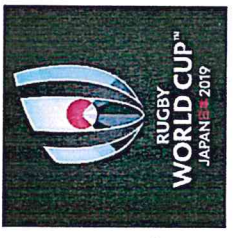
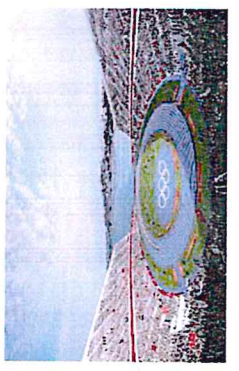

LITERACY:

This term we will be looking in depth at Aesop's fables, biographies and a setting description all relating to our topic.

Children will be revising and learning key SPaG terms and learning how we use these within our writing.

NUMERACY:

Children will be focusing on the four operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division) Looking at formal methods that will be used.

We will then move onto looking at fractions and in particular looking at equivalent fractions and begin to calculate certain fractions of amounts.

SCIENCE:

We will be learning about 'electricity' this term, in particular we will look at how electricity is generated and what appliances run on them.

Furthermore we will build and construct circuits looking how to solve problems with them. Finally we will look at which materials conduct and insulate electricity.

ART and DT:

We are going to design and create our own medals for the 2020 Olympic Games.

Curriculum Overview – Spring Term

HISTORY/ GEOGRAPHY:

Throughout our history and geography sessions, children will be focusing on:

- Olympic history
- Global sporting events.
- Individual sports and their countries of origin.
- Famous sporting athletes.

ICT:

In this unit, we will be looking at creating our own music, using certain programmes to design and create our own tunes.

We will put our own ideas and characters into the game and will be asking younger children to trial our games.

PE:

Children will be learning to develop their game skills through a variety of games. They will work individually and in teams. They will be thinking tactically about games and developing their understanding of rules.

This term the focus will be on Cricket.

RE:

Throughout this unit children will be learning about the five pillars of Islam. Children will learn:

- What they are
- Their meanings and importance for people who follow Islam.
- How it can be incorporated into everyday life.

MUSIC:

We will be analysing previous opening Olympic ceremonies and creating and performing our own through dance and music.

Children will be taking part in weekly music session. This will be conducted through weekly singing
