General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR)

As of 25th May, new laws about how we manage your data in school come into force. This is an update to previous data protection laws.

This will mean that school will be sending new forms to obtain permission for things such as photographs and some information about our school. We now need specific consent to do this.

Most of the information we collect and hold is mandatory (we hold this as a school under the Education Act) but we will give you a choice for other voluntary information including information about some school events.
